

Działalność lekarska Juliana Talko-Hryncewicza

The medical work of Julian Talko-Hryncewicz

SUMMARY

The medical work and writings of Julian Talko-Hryncewicz (1850-1936) stemmed in a natural way from his family roots, his professional career and his intellectual interests. It has to be noted, though, that most of his research was in the field of anthropology and that purely medical works accounted for a rather less significant share of his scientific achievement. In his medical writings he was concerned mainly with case reports, he published book reviews, descriptions, memoirs and reports. However, the issues raised in his papers and books on anthropology straddled the borderline between medical science and clinical practice, on the one hand, and a broadly understood comparative anthropology, on the other. The places where Talko-Hryncewicz was active as a physician included the Ukraine, Eastern Siberia, and St. Petersburg.
